- Positive attitude and enthusiasm
- Extra-curricular activities and/or community/philanthropic involvement
- Satisfactory academic record
- Desire to continue their education

SUBMISSION MUST INCLUDE:

A completed student application cover sheet
A completed student profile, including student essay
2 letters of recommendation (one from a C. K. McClatchy High administrator, counselor, teacher or
coach; and one from outside the school, such as an employer or community leader)
Official high school transcript
Optional: news articles, flyers, pictures or anything pertaining to the applicant's activities and
achievements (limit 5 pages). No videos, DVDs or CDs please.

Late or incomplete applications will NOT be reviewed.

SUBMISSION DEADLINE:

Completed applications must be received no later than <u>5 pm, Friday, May 8th, 2020</u> at the following email address:

SELECTION PROCESS:

Applications will be screened for accuracy and compliance with scholarship criteria. A committee consisting of the foundation's directors and volunteers will review the applications and select students to participate in virtual interviews conducted on **Wednesday**, **May 20th**, **2020**. Final selection of winners will be made by the foundation's review committee.

NOTIFICATION OF WINNERS:

The scholarship winners will be informed by mail.

AWARD LEVELS:

Up to three winners will receive \$2,000 each. A separate spirit award of \$1,000 may also be given.
