

## 2021 Student Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ) Sheet

- Summer @ Virtual City Hall (S@CH) is a six-week summer program taught by credentialed high school teachers with an emphasis on civic engagement and youth development principles. Participants will engage in virtual interactive group classes while learning about local government structure and how to become active members in their communities. Students will also complete a group project and presentation for Sacramento's City Council. Classroom sessions are weekly, Monday through Friday from 9:00 AM 12:00 PM, with Life Skills Workshops on afternoons. These classes will be held virtually via Zoom or Google Classroom.
- Selected students are required to attend virtually two <u>mandatory</u> sessions including the *Student & Parent/Guardian Orientation* scheduled for *Saturday*, *June 5<sup>th</sup> 10:00 AM 12:00 PM*, plus the first Life Skills Workshops titled, *Being Prepared for a Job/Internship*, scheduled for *Friday*, *June 18<sup>th</sup> 9:00 12:00 PM*. Instructional class sessions begin Monday, June 21<sup>st</sup> with an ending date of Friday, July 24<sup>th</sup>.
- During the S@VCH program, students must attend instructional classroom sessions <u>AND</u> complete their 42-hour workshop to receive the stipend and five high school credits\*. (\*Students attending an eligible NUSD, SCUSD, or TRUSD high school will receive a stipend and five-elective high school credits. Students who do not attend any of these school districts but live within the Sacramento city limits are considered <u>At-Large students</u>. These students will receive the stipend along with a letter indicating completion of community service hours for their instructional classroom time instead of elective credits.)
- The required **42-hour Workshop** begins Monday, June 28<sup>th</sup> and all hours are required to be completed by Friday, July 24<sup>th</sup>.
