

District-Managed Scholarships for 2017

Tips for applying:

1. Only scholarships that are completed and submitted by the deadline will be considered.
2. Neatness Counts! If you are not typing the application, please be neat! (all essays must be typed)
3. The school letter of recommendation needs to be on school letterhead if possible.
4. The outside letter can be from a coach **that works at a different school; and MUST NOT BE ON YOUR SCHOOL'S LETTERHEAD!**
5. Letters of applications and transcript must be opened and stapled with your packet.
6. On the individual Student Profile, be sure to list your accomplishments! For long-term goals, be specific. Don't just fill in that you want to give back to the community or do volunteer work. Be specific in the areas you want to accomplish those tasks.
7. Proofread your application, and especially your essay.

Antonio Medrana, \$1,000

New this year. Letters of recommendations need contact information; 3 separate essays; preference to students who were enrolled in a Sac City bilingual programs.

Grant Bennett, \$2,500

Student must enroll and attend a University of California campus.

Carpenter's Local Union No. 46, \$1,000 (3 scholarships given each year)

A GPA of 2.0; list family members with union ties (if no family members, fill in with a family friend); leaving blank will not disqualify you. You **MUST** address unions in your essay (and not just the first two sentences from a Google search).

CK McClatchy Class of 66, \$1000+

Only open to CKM. Must apply on line.

Dell'Orto Simmons Scholarship, \$2,500 for two years

Only open to CKM students. No minimum GPA required.

Susan Cherveney, \$500

Preference given to students who attended Will C. Wood Junior High School.

John and Charlotte Church, \$1,000

No specific requirements. Only open to CKM students.

Thomas Eustis, \$700

The entire scholarship **MUST BE TYPED**; they look for students attending a 4-year college with an emphasis on math and science.

Luella Goff, \$900 for 4 years

A 4-year scholarship. Students can be enrolled in a two-year college for the first 2 years; then transfer to a 4-year college.

Jewell O'Connell, \$1,000 (3 scholarships given each year)

No special requirements.
