MINIMUM 1. FAFSA or Dream Act 2. GPA Verification March 2, 2018 Annually

*Foster Youth are encouraged to attend to get help with the Chafee Grant application!*

- Student's Social Security card and drivers license (or government issued ID), if available
- Parent's Social Security card (if available)
- Parent's federal income tax return** from tax year 2016
- Records of untaxed income** such as child support, TANF, interest income, veterans non-education benefits, Social Security benefits
- Student's 2016 federal income tax return, or evidence of income earned (W-2 form or pay records)
- Bank account records or statements
- Records of stocks, bonds or investments
- Business records
- If not a US citizen, bring alien registration card (if available)
- A list of the colleges you are interested in

## REMEMBER!

To apply for a Cal Grant you must submit the FAFSA or Dream Act application and Cal Grant GPA verification. Public high schools and public charter schools are required to submit their current senior year students' certified GPAs, unless the parent or student has opted out. Verify with your school!
